Outsourced manufacturing is only undertaken where suppliers can demonstrate (either by Australian Standards or by other International Standards) that they comply fully with regard to raw materials, production processes including such aspects as packaging and warehousing.

Rojone conducts regular training courses and seminars to all staff at all levels in the importance of maintaining our environmental policy both in house and in dealing with suppliers to ensure that our products meet the strictest standards of other government policies. Particular emphasis is placed on hazardous materials, waste management and recycling of packaging and other production process materials.
